He was a finalist in the Junior Division with Lil Saintz in 2019, a Bronze Medalist at HHI Worlds in Arizona, USA the same year, and more recently in 2023, he was a Regional Finalist in the Adult Division with Vanquish and a Mega School Division Finalist with MDC Massey Dance Crew. Additionally, Dallas has demonstrated leadership skills in dance as the leader of the Massey Dance Crew in 2023.
